HIS LEG WAS FINALLY AMPUTATED, BUT HE DIED ABOUT OCT. 15TH AT HOSPITAL # 11 AT BUDAPEST OF GANGRENE POISONING. LT. RHODES WAS PRESENT AT HIS DEATH, AS HE WAS BEING TREATED FOR INJURIES AT THE  
SAME PLACE.
