

10 April 1944

Today's target was an airfield at Bourges, France. No enemy aircraft were encountered and the usual amount of flak was observed. Major Jamison flew Command Pilot in the deputy lead ship of the first Section. Capt. Whitlow lead the second Section and Capt. Glenn was deputy lead of the second section. Lt. Brudos - crew 63, Capt. Glenn - crew 73, Lt. Burtis - crew 62 Capt. Whitlow - crew 65, Lt. Vogel - crew 74, and Lt. Olney - crew 75.

11 April 1944

Oschersleben, Germany was the target of today's mission. The following crews participated, Lt. Burtis - crew 62, Lt. Brudos - crew 63, Lt. Vogel - crew 74, Lt. Wells - crew 70 and Lt. Stewart - crew 76. Lt. Brudos flew the deputy lead ship in the first section and took the lead during the bomb run. One pass was made on our formation by enemy aircraft.

12 April 1944

Today's mission was recalled before reaching the enemy coast so no sortie credits were given.
