IT IS PRESUMED THAT FOR ONE REASON OR ANOTHER HE DECIDED TO GO FORWARD TOWARDS THE BOMB BAY BUT COULD NOT LEAVE THE PLANE BECAUSE IT SOON WENT INTO A VERY STEEP SPIRAL. HE WAS NOT INJURED WHEN LAST SEEN. PRESUMING HE WAS KILLED IN THE CRASH OF THE PLANE.
