KNOWN INFORMATION:

The 1st. 8 men of crew returned with me from Yugoslavia. They are all returning home.

HEARSAY INFORMATION:

The only information I have concerning the two gunners is from the chetnics we were with. They described two men to us that fitted the two gunners. Due to the fact that we never heard any more from them, we come to the conclusion that the story was true. We all jumped out in the middle of the enemy, it is very likely that some were captured.
