STATEMENT

I, FRANK SCHREIBER, First Lieutenant, Air Corps, Army Serial Number O-529673, state that on 18 August 1944, I was flying as Pilot of a B-24 type aircraft, in Number 10 position of "A" Flight. Since I am a member of the 759th Bombardment Squadron (Hv) AAF, 459th Bombardment Group (Hv) AAF, and was flying in their flight, I do not know where Captain PEOPLES was originally flying. The first time I noticed him was after our successful bombing run, when we were quite a ways from the target. He was flying to the left and much lower than our flight, all alone and steadily dropping back. His number one engine was feathered but I do not know what caused it. My Navigators checked our position at 44° 55' N - 22° 30' E at approximately 1200 hours. That is all I know of this occurrence.
